

Our experienced pulmonologists and experts in the respiratory system perform exams and tests to help determine any lung related diagnosis, including:

- CT scan to get detailed images of the bones, muscles, fat organs, and blood vessels in your chest.
- Chest fluoroscopy to see how well your lungs are functioning.
- Chest ultrasound to examine the organs and other chest structures.
- Pleural biopsy to remove a small tissue sample from the pleura, which is the membrane that surrounds your lungs.
- Pulmonary function test to see how well your lungs are working.
- Pulse Oximetry test and arterial blood gases analysis to determine the oxygen saturation level in your blood and level of ventilation.
- Thoracentesis to remove air or fluid from around your lungs.
- Bronchoscopy to examine your airways, determine if you have any issues in your trachea, lower airways, throat, or larynx and to take tissue samples.
- Sleep study to help them diagnose sleep disorders, such as sleep apnea.
- Allergy Prick skin test and serum IgE Panels test to pinpoint the allergens responsible of causing the allergic symptoms.
